Why credentials are important.

EARNING CREDENTIALS

- Every team member must obtain at least one industry recognized certification
- If your members of your team have already obtained a certificate, this will be recognized



SUGGESTED CERTIFICATES

- CompTIA IT Fundamentals
- CompTIA A+
- Cisco Certified Technition
- Cisco Certified Entry Networking Technician

Team members that have already earned these or other industry recognized credentials may consider more advanced certificates to expand their areas of expertise.



POSTING CREDENTIALS

- Your coach will need to submit team members' names, cite the credentials earned along with the source and date of achievement
- Credential acknowledgments should be made on the web
